Deep, decomposed granite soils on the slopes of the Darling Hills, with a cooling effect in the warm afternoons from the Atlantic Ocean in close proximity. Vineyard type: Bush Vine, dry land

in the cellar

A portion of the wine spend 8-12 months on staves and to add complexity and layers, this wines is blended with other components.
