food suggestions

Enjoy this wine with slowly braised beef short ribs.

in the vineyard

Terroir: Warmer sites are selected to give full ripe grapes with dark colour and soft tannins. Soils from decomposed granite. Hutton soils dominate the sites selected for this wine.

Vineyard type: Bush Vine, no irrigation

about the harvest

Yield: 5 - 6 t/ha

Balling at Harvest: 24 - 25°B

in the cellar

Vinification: Crush and destalk, 5 - 10 days fermentation at 20 - 28°C.

Maturation: After malolactic fermentation, wine is aged in tanks for 12 months. Staves are used to add complexity and structure.
